## CALCULATION OF INCOME

Income qualifications may be determined by one of the following processes:
Most current last 30 days check stubs (if weekly add checks, divide by \# of check stubs (normally will be 4 ), multiply by 52 , divide by 12 ; if bi-weekly add check stubs, divide by \# of check stubs (normally will be 2 ), multiply by 26 ; if bi-monthly add check stubs, divide by \# of check stubs (normally will be 2), multiply by 24 . These total will get a yearly income for wages. If monthly Income (child support, Social Security, TANF, etc.) multiply by 12 to get a yearly amount.
