CALCULATION OF INCOME

Income qualifications may be determined by one of the following processes:

Most current last 30 days check stubs (if weekly add checks, divide by # of check stubs (normally will be 4), multiply by 52, divide by 12; if bi-weekly add check stubs, divide by # of check stubs (normally will be 2), multiply by 26; if bi-monthly add check stubs, divide by # of check stubs (normally will be 2), multiply by 24. These total will get a yearly income for wages. If monthly Income (child support, Social Security, TANF, etc.) multiply by 12 to get a yearly amount.
