Poverty Income Guidelines Effective October 1, 2025

People in the Household	Maximum Income (200% of Poverty Rate)
1	\$31,300.00
2	\$42,300.00
3	\$53,300.00
4	\$64,300.00
5	\$75,300.00
6	\$86,300.00
7	\$97,300.00
8	\$108,300.00
For each additional person in the household with more than 8 people, add:	\$11,000.00

CALCULATION OF INCOME

Income qualifications may be determined by one of the following processes:

Most current last 30 days check stubs; if weekly add checks, divide by # of check stubs (normally will be 4), multiply by 52, divide by 12; if bi-weekly add check stubs, divide by # of check stubs (normally will be 2), multiply by 26; if bi-monthly add check stubs, divide by # of check stubs (normally will be 2), multiply by 24. These total will get a yearly income for wages. If monthly income (child support, Social Security, TANF, etc.) multiply by 12 to get a yearly amount.
